Here are some ways you can connect with your neighbours this Neighbour Day (or any day).



## **Offer to exchange contact details in case of an emergency.**

If you feel comfortable, let your neighbours know they can call you if they need help.



## **Get to know the interests of your neighbours.**

What do they enjoy doing or what would they like to do?



## **Link people you know that may appreciate each other's company in your street, or in your neighbourhood.**

Connecting to one another lessens social isolation and creates a greater sense of community.



## **Ask your neighbours how long they have lived in the area.**

Most would love to tell you the history of the suburb or street!



## **Try carpooling or walking together if your children go to the same school.**

Expanding your friend group is a bonus for grandparents, parents and children alike.
